**Envirothon NB is a community-based initiative** that affects not only the students involved but also their communities and society as a whole. As such, this program significantly impacts how these communities value their environment, which can influence community decisions and activities.

To optimize the enrichment experience of each student, the program combines:

- **Aquatics**
